

NOTICE OF EIA & WULA PROCESS

PROPOSED NORDEX EURONOTUS CONCRETE TOWER FACILITY

Proposed Activity and Locality:

Notice is hereby given that **Nordex Energy South Africa (Pty) Ltd** will be applying for an Environmental Authorisation for the proposed **Euronotus Concrete Tower Facility / Factory**, in terms of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, 2014, as amended. This application will be done in terms of activities listed in Government Notice Regulation 327 & 324 of 7 April 2017, published in terms of Section 24(5) of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998, as amended.

The proposed activities require that a Basic Assessment process be undertaken and the relevant authority is the Western Cape Department of Environmental Affairs and Development Planning (DEADP).

Nordex Energy SA will also apply for a Water Use Licence / General Authorisation for water uses under Section 21, in terms of the National Water Act, 1998 (No. 36 of 1998) to the Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS).

The proposed project entails the construction and operations of a concrete tower factory that will manufacture concrete towers for the developing windfarms. The site area to be cleared and developed is approximately 10 hectares in extent.

The Euronotus Concrete Tower Facility will be located on the Farm Nuwerus No. 284, in the Laingsburg Local Municipality, Central Karoo District Municipality, of the Western Cape.

The geographic co-ordinates of the central point: 32°58'58.87"S, 20°33'30.37"E. The site is located approximately 28km north of Matjiesfontein, along the R354.
