

## NOTICE OF AIR EMISSIONS LICENSE RENEWAL

Notice is hereby given that Autocast Ferrous (Pty) Ltd. will be applying for the Renewal of the Air Emission Licence (AEL), in terms of the National Environmental Management: Air Quality Act (39 of 2004).

Autocast Ferrous (Pty) Ltd manufactures grey, white and ductile cast iron products for automotive, mining and general applications. The National Environmental Management: Air Quality Act (39 of 2004) warrants that listed activities require an AEL. The manufacturing of cast iron products triggers the following activities listed in Government Notice No. 893, 2013, as amended: Category 4: Subcategory 4.10: Foundry – melting and/ or casting of iron, including the cleaning of castings and handling of casting mould materials.

Autocast Ferrous (Pty) Ltd holds an AEL (NMBM AEL 13/27(01)) which is due to expire shortly (28 February 2025) and therefore needs to be renewed. No changes to the facility or licenced activities are proposed.

An AEL renewal application will be submitted for a decision by the Nelson Mandela Bay Municipality: department of Environmental Health. In terms of Section 47 of the NEM:AQA, the applicant must take the necessary steps to bring the application to the attention of interested and affected parties (IAPs).

CEN Integrated Environmental Management Unit (CEN IEM Unit) has been appointed by the applicant to undertake the required public participation process related to the AEL renewal application.

Interested and affected parties are invited to submit comments and/or register on the project database to CEN IEM unit (contact details listed below). Comments and/or requests for registration must be submitted by **3 June 2024**.
